

NORTH AMERICAN REFRACTORIES COMPANY ASBESTOS PERSONAL INJURY SETTLEMENT TRUST

Procedures for Supplementing Presumptive NARCO Exposure Occupations

1. Following meetings with Honeywell International Inc. (“Honeywell”), the NARCO Asbestos Trust Advisory Committee (“TAC”), and the NARCO Future Claimants Representative (“FCR”) on December 9, 2013, and February 24, 2014, the Trustees of the NARCO Asbestos Trust adopted guidelines and procedures for establishing NARCO exposure under the NARCO Trust Distribution Procedures.
2. Among other provisions, the guidelines provide for presumptively establishing NARCO exposure at sites with NARCO asbestos-containing products for claimants who work in designated occupations and designated industries. The Trustees developed a schedule of the designated occupations and industries, labeled “Presumptive NARCO Chart.” The NARCO Asbestos Trust published the Presumptive NARCO Chart dated February 25, 2014, at www.narcoasbestostrust.org.
3. To add occupations to the Presumptive NARCO Chart, a person may submit a proposal to the NARCO Asbestos Trust which identifies the proposed additional occupation(s) with the designated industries and provides a written statement of reasons supporting the proposal. The proposal with supporting statement shall be sent by email or regular mail to the Trustees with a copy to Trust counsel Sander Esserman.
4. The Trustees will review the proposal as soon as practicable. If the Trustees find evidentiary or other problems or deficiencies with the proposal, the Trustees will provide the person submitting the proposal with a notice and an opportunity to supplement the proposal. The person submitting the proposal may submit additional evidence or materials within 60 days of the notice.
5. The NARCO Asbestos Trust will forward the proposal with supporting statement to the TAC and the FCR for comment and consultation, with a request that responses to the proposal be provided to the Trustees within 60 days. The TAC or the FCR may request that the Trustees schedule a meeting to discuss the proposal.
6. The NARCO Asbestos Trust will also forward the proposal to the Trust’s claims facility, consultants and counsel for analysis and comment.
7. Following the consultation process with the TAC and the FCR, the Trustees will decide whether to adopt the proposed additions. The Trustees will inform the proponent, the TAC and the FCR of their decision. The Trustees will publish any additions to the Presumptive NARCO Chart on the [NARCO Trust’s Documents Page](#).
